

Inspection of Cargo at Sea

The following inspection routines shall apply after the vessels has left the load port:

The first 3 days after leaving the load port, inspections shall take place daily.

Inspection shall continue with an interval of maximum 3 days, after the initial 3 days.

If encountering bad weather inspection shall be performed as long and often as necessary according to the judgement of the vessels command.

Lashings shall be tightened, corrected or added if needed, according to good seamanship.

NB! All inspections and actions to be noted down in the vessel's deck log book.
