

Labelling of Cargo

Höegh Autoliners have developed two types of cargo labels to indicate discharge ports.

Port hangers: To be used on all vehicles, where it is practically possible to use them. (Exception: Where manufacturer has denied Höegh Autoliners to use them)

Port stickers: To be used on cargo where it is not practical to use “port hangers”.

Where bar code labels are used, the main part is to be placed on the left rear window in the upper left corner.

Standard position for labels on trucks is in lower left corner of the windscreen, easy readable from left side of unit. Standard position for labels on HH units is on left side (where appropriate), in a height easy readable for tally.

Information stickers are to be used as information labels, and according to instructions, common sense and good seamanship.
