

Receiving Cargo

Cargo is usually delivered by truck, train or barge to the terminal.



Each individual cargo unit to be received must be mapped against a Höegh Autoliners booking number. If cargo is found not having a booking number, Höegh Autoliners local booking office must be contacted and a booking number received, before cargo may be received.

Shipper to ensure that all cargo to be exported is thoroughly cleaned. Used vehicles, machinery and spare parts must be free from soil and /or plant material before being shipped. Special cleaning requirements might apply in some areas.

Höegh Autoliners local booking office to be called if cargo is not up to local stevedoring or Höegh Autoliners standards (mechanically, safety, security, including flat tires).
